What I think I want I do not have. Someone else has it. What I do not have I do not value or appreciate. I am green with envy. What they have is much more desirable in my mind.”

Envy is a poisonous attitude that affects so many of us. It keeps us from enjoying the blessings of our own lives. It relies upon us putting down and devaluing the gifts God gives us and elevating the gifts God gives others.

We learn to be envious in our lives because society does not teach us to value everything as gifts from God. Society chooses what it wishes to value and teaches us to do the same. We become selective in our valuations of others and things. We buy into the world's value system and compromise our own happiness in the process.

Joseph and his brothers fell into this trap, both, equally guilty of false valuation. Their father taught them well.
