**Come Holy Spirit**

The Holy Spirit is one of the most difficult concepts for many of us to understand. We know it as the third person of the Trinity. Then, our knowledge stops. Some grow up in a more Pentecostal tradition and see the Spirit as speaking in tongues and more electrically charged worship. Some see a radically energetic church. We also think of spirited preaching.

When we read the book of Acts, we see all of this. We also see quiet meditation and being in control of oneself. We see works of ministry; healing the sick, clothing the naked, feeding the hungry and comforting the afflicted. We see people sharing their resources with those in need.

Luke, writer of Acts wants his readers to know the Holy Spirit is the source of power for ministry for the church as a whole; not just the pastor or a few "spirited people." The whole church is called to ministry and the whole church is empowered by the Holy Spirit to do the work of ministry. Today we call upon the Holy Spirit to infuse us with a new enthusiasm for the work to which God has called us.
