When the Voice of God Speaks...

God is in the business of connecting with us. His self-communication is sometimes very clear to us. At other times, His self-communication is a mystery to be sorted out and unraveled. We marvel at the one of a kind ways God speaks to people in the Bible. Adam and Eve hear the voice of God in garden telling them what they can and cannot do. Noah hears God speak to him about building an Ark. Abraham hears God say, I have for you a promised land. Moses hears God say, "Go to Pharaoh and tell him to let my people go."
