## Sacrifice Makes Right?

Religious belief in humans is a source for moral behavior. Christian living comes from Christian teaching which is born from faith in a Christ who is willing to teach us. Faith is, trusting that the one doing the teaching is worthy of our trust. Trusting is about staking a claim to the belief that the object of our faith will provide a stable set of beliefs and priorities for our lives.

What we see in ancient belief systems is an understanding that when a moral failure occurs, someone must make a sacrifice to make it right. In many of our relationships when we fail to live up to the expectations of a loved one or friend we often try to find a way to do something to make it right. Sacrifices are made, favors are done, we make ourselves beholden to another. Old Testament faith assumes that when a moral failure takes place an animal sacrifice is required to make it right. In exodus, the lambs' blood on the door posts of the Hebrews in Egypt is what keeps them from death. Temple sacrifices were offered for the same reason.

In New Testament theology, Jesus becomes this one time sacrifice for all sin, of all people, for all time. To say, "Jesus died for me is to say I know my sins are covered by his blood. I can do nothing to atone or make right my sin." Having faith in Christ, I live in and by the Grace of God. Holy Communion reminds us of this. It reminds us that God has provided this sacrifice for our benefit. God has made us right.
