Biblical Truth God chose Gideon, an average man who was weak and fearful, and supplied the necessary power to accomplish His purposes in His ways.

Biblical Context God raised a total of twelve judges to lead the sinful nation of Israel back to Him. Deborah was the third judge, and Gideon was the fourth. Gideon thought of himself as weak and fearful. But, in a divine encounter, God told Gideon He would greatly use him. Through Gideon, God showed His ability to transform a weak and imperfect person into “mighty warrior” (Jdg. 6:12).
