Seeking Truth; Living Truth

There is a difference between being right and seeking truth. It is the difference between doing the right thing in a wrong way or doing the wrong thing in the right way. It is like the difference between Justice and Mercy.

Many people are blameless in their lives and wind up being victims of crime. Some will accuse them of bringing it on themselves. Others will do that which is legal but ill-advised and destructive of relationships which are sacred. Their motive is profit and self-advancement.

Jesus had a way of looking through sham and pretense. His gaze was often on the heart of peoples' actions...what motivated them. The reason he was despised by the Pharisees and Sadducees is that he called their hand on that which they did to profit at the expense of others. He questioned their actions when they created burdens for those less powerful and in the process made their own lives easier. Jesus promoted the truth and especially when it liberated the powerless and made their burdens lighter.

Jesus understood that when we are children of God it means we are to care for one another in the most genuine way possible. Sometimes this means being inconvenienced. Sometimes it means putting the real needs of another above our own wants and desires.
