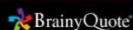

Jesus Is Different

In our Gospel lesson for this Sunday, Jesus heals the sick, casts out demons and teaches with the kind of authority the scribes do not have. His demeanor is very different than that of ordinary people. He understands the scriptures in a different way. He is able to speak with demons and cast them out of people possessed. Jesus has the authority, the power and the courage to tackle that which frightens most of us.

The ones who begin to follow Jesus are intrigued with how he conducts himself. He is one different human being. He is the Son of God. He is a man who is full of light and life and he does not allow darkness and death, illness and dysfunction in the world to frighten him.

The transformative power he offers us through the Holy Spirit can do the same for us; give us the ability to clarify that which is confusing, to bring light where there is darkness, speak peace where there is conflict, soothe the ruffled feathers of those who are upset and send that which is evil packing.

God sent Jesus into the world to help us see Him better. Jesus is every bit of a God that a human being can be and he is every bit of a human being that God can be. He is fully human and fully divine. He is sent to show us the way to live and share life with one another. He is here to show us how to make peace with one another. He is here to show us how to care for one another. He is here to show us how to forgive one another. He is here to show us how to repent of our sinfulness and be restored to the community of faith. This is why we call him Lord.
