In today's lectionary scripture we encounter Jesus as he returns to His hometown after performing many miracles and healings. He probably returns expecting a hero's welcome but in turn receives a welcome of unbelief and rejection. His response shows us the type of leader He was. Seeing the rejection by those who knew Him, He commissions the disciples to go and continue to do His work. This commissioning continues the work of Christ and teaches the disciples to be apostles. This passage in our current culture helps us to articulate how we approach missions work in our local neighborhoods and in communities and nations abroad. When we view the act of sharing the gospel in the context of the great commission it should lead all of us towards an attitude of faithful obedience to sharing God's love with others and teaching them how to love God back. The questions that it leads me to ask myself is... What am I striving for? Are my goals in line with the calling of God in my life? Am I following the commission of "going" and making disciples? So, what questions are you thinking of?
