**On Being a Good Father**

Fatherhood is a challenge to many men. We want to do well but do not always have great role models for being a good father. Some of us grew up with absent fathers who worked all the time. Other had fathers who had their good times with their buddies away from the family. Still others had fathers who were abusive and did not have a tender side. Some had fathers who seemed angry and frustrated all the time and to approach them was an exercise in misery.

Being a good father is about being present to let our children know they are gifts of God to us. It is about being sensitive enough to hear the longing of their hearts and not see this as weakness. It is about learning to have fun with the family and not apart from the family. Being a good healthy father is about finding other ways to express our frustration and anger rather than taking it out on the children.

Being a good father is about compassion and sensitivity as well as firmness. It is about looking to Jesus as a model of behavior and teaching what we see in Jesus by precept and by example. It is about being encouraging and helping our children grow into confident adults in their own right. Being a good father is sometimes about learning to say, "I was wrong. Please forgive me."
