How Do We Pray?

What do I pray for? Great question! What is in your heart? When you pray, how do you pray? Do you pray as one who is driven by selfish ambition, bitterness and conceit?

Prayer is a double-edged sword. It connects us to God but often it is a way of trying to advance our own selfish and unhealthy agenda. Will God honor this kind of prayer? Another good question.

In the New Testament we get some advice from Paul, “Pray in the spirit.” This means, enter into our spiritual connection with God and allow the spirit of God to influence the things we pray for. Part of this advice is to end your prayer, “In the name of Christ I pray.” Ending a prayer this way allows us to be reminded that Christ is Lord of our lives and in so being has ultimate say in how we live our lives.

Dr. Don Saliers says, “Prayer is a way of intending the world.” What he means is, prayer helps us to see what God wants and to bring our wants, desires, and way of living into conformity with God’s will.
