Living the Full Life

Many of us have the opportunity to live a life that is abundant and full. Some of us have it all in the material sense and yet we feel empty. Our lives long for a missing ingredient we have difficulty finding.

Jesus has a way of helping us discover the missing ingredients. He demonstrates, by his own way of living, how we can live too. He shows us a manner of living that embraces God, finding purpose beyond our own selves and in the one who has made us. Jesus models this with what he does for us in the time period we call Holy Week.

Today is Palm Sunday, which is when we honor the day of Palms and waving coats. I call the Friday before Easter "Black Friday" because it is the day Jesus died on the cross. There will be a different type of service on this day. We will join together in the chapel and read passages of scripture to remind ourselves of the story of Jesus' Crucifixion. It is a darker and more foreboding service than most. It puts us in a place where we can truly celebrate the Resurrection on Easter Sunday because we have been to the foot of the cross.
