# MOSES

## THE CHOSEN TRACKER

The Israelites were disobedient when Moses went to Mount Sinai to receive the Ten Commandments. The commandments were given by God to help guide His people in a holy way of living. The first commandment was, "You should not have any other gods besides Me." And the second commandment was, "You should never worship idols." In their impatience, God's people had done both—creating and worshipping false gods instead of God Himself. Sometimes we may be tempted to make other things more important than God, but we must always remember that God's commandments are meant to draw us closer in relationship with Him.
